Isobel and Tommy Thompson have been the heart and soul of Whitevale for a very long time. To commemorate Isobel's life and dedication, the Whitevale and District Residents' Association (WDRA) has decided to honour her memory with a bench and three large trees in the Whitevale Park.

The pad has been laid and the bench will be positioned to face in two directions; one towards Duffin's Creek and the other towards the children's playground. The three trees planted around it will be native trees and each will colour at different seasons of the year. Alongside the trees there will be a perennial garden that will be looked after by the residents of Whitevale.

We have started a "*Whitevale Gardening Club*" and part of their responsibility will be the planting, watering, and ongoing maintenance of the trees and garden. The City of Pickering has provided the cement pad, the remainder will be done by the residents, former residents and friends of Whitevale.
